Documents that are **REQUIRED** to be presented the day of registration:

- Child's original birth certificate
- Immunization record
- 2 proofs of residency

Pennsylvania State Law requires each child entering school for the first time to have the following immunizations before school begins:

- Diphtheria and Tetanus (DTap, DTP, Td or DT): 4 doses, with at least 1 dose being on or after the fourth birthday
- Polio (OPV or IPV): 3 doses
- Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR): 2 doses with the first one on or after 12 months of age
- Hepatitis B (HBV): 3 doses appropriately spaced apart
- Varicella (Chicken Pox Vaccine): 2 doses of vaccine or history of disease

The immunization requirements are a condition of attendance at any public, private, or parochial school in Pennsylvania. Parents will be expected to produce evidence of the immunizations or their child will be denied entrance to school until the requirements are met.

**Other required documents:** The Department of Health mandates that a complete physical and dental examination be completed upon entrance into school. These dated examinations will be accepted up to one year prior to the start of school.

**What to expect when you and your child go to Kindergarten Registration:** Parents and students will rotate through stations, sometimes separate from each other. Parents will complete several forms. Picking up the registration packet at orientation on February 22 will provide parents with an opportunity to complete forms in advance. Students will work with teachers, reading specialists, and speech pathologists to participate in screening activities.
